

## Sample Champion - Application note # 6

### MLS and pink filter. Why use it?

In some circumstances, it could be useful to have a pink noise generator, especially when an octave or third-octave frequency analysis is required. Sample Champion can pink-filter the MLS signal. Here below there are some examples (with "loop back" configuration).

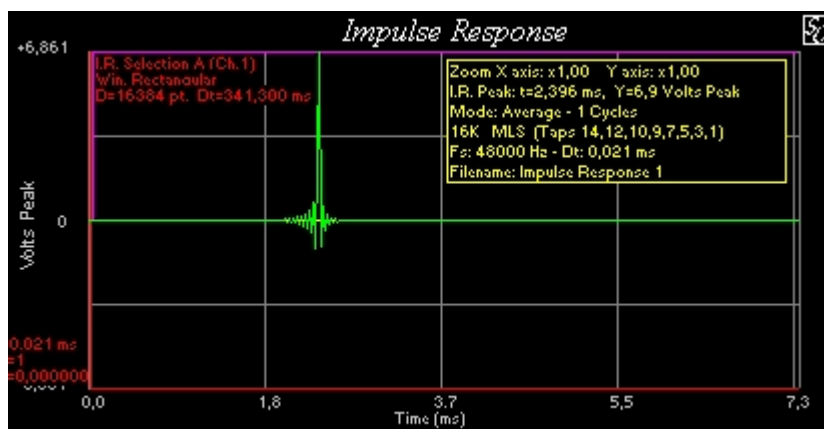


Figure 1 - "Flat" impulse response

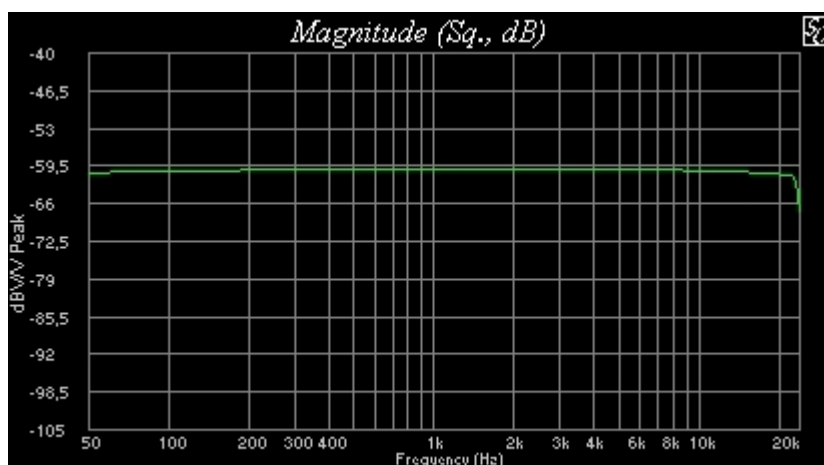


Figure 2 - "Flat" frequency response from the impulse response plotted in figure 1

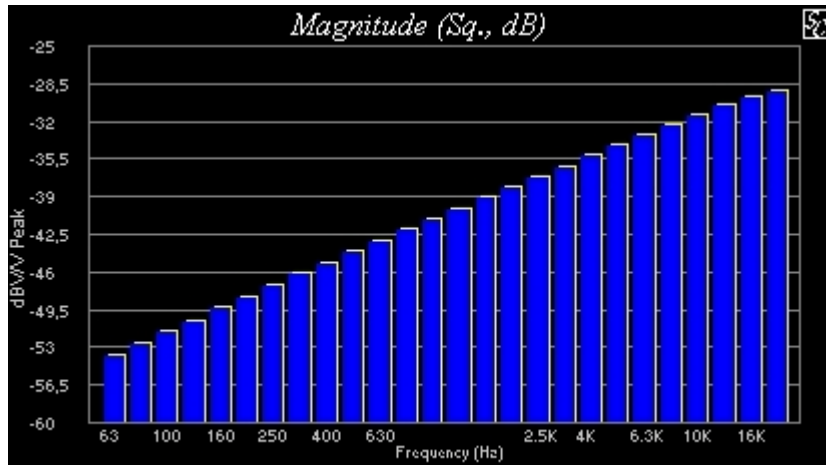


Figure 3 - Third octave analysis of the "flat" frequency response plotted in figure 2; the difference between adjacent 1/3 octave bands is equal to 1 dB

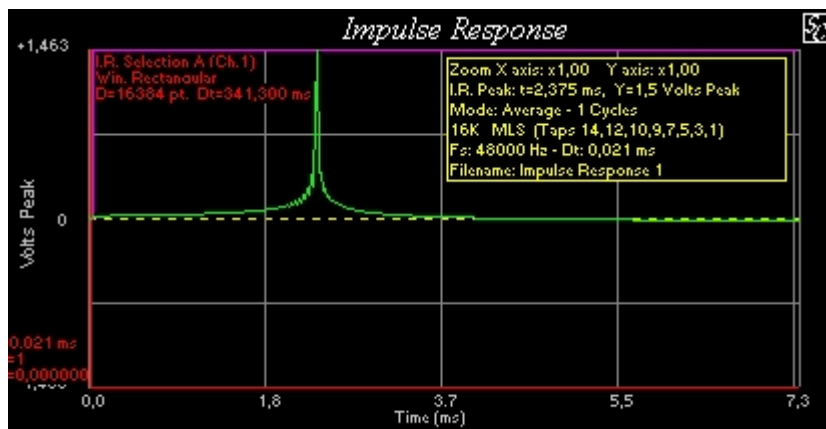


Figure 4 - Impulse response measured in the same conditions of figure 1, but using a pink-filtered MLS signal

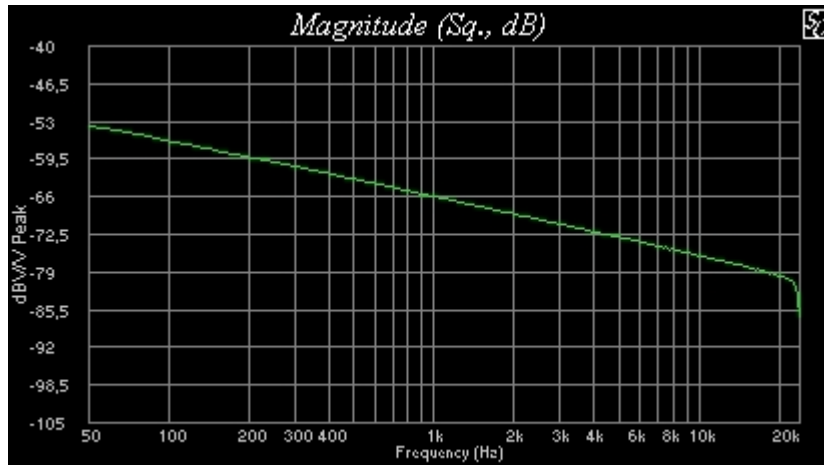


Figure 5 - Frequency response from the impulse response plotted in figure 4

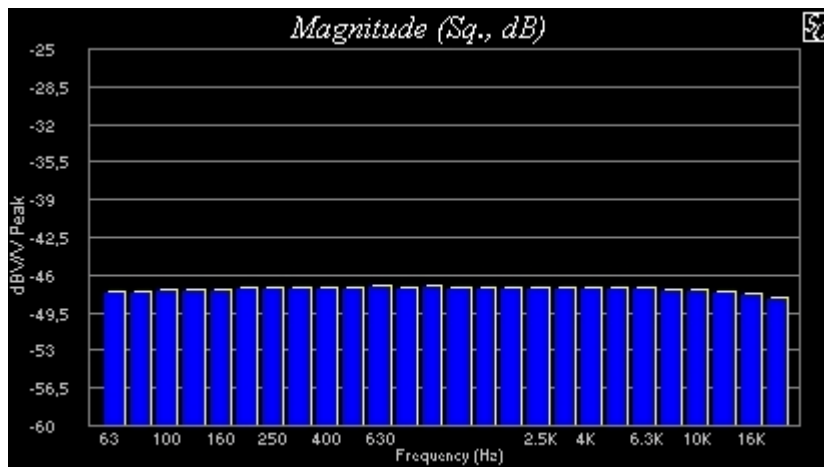


Figure 6 - Third octave analysis of the frequency response plotted in figure 5
